The market runs from 5-9pm on the Second Friday of each month in Centennial Square (at the corner of Main St. and Academy St.)

- The artist must be present to sell his or her work.
- Individual spaces will be limited to 10x10
- Artists/Crafters must bring their own tents, tables, chairs, and other materials necessary for their display.
